# MEET ELLISE

Ellise Fuller, one of our young members, suffers with severe anxiety and depression. To help her with her mental health Ellise visited Legacy regularly where she learnt that she had a natural flare for music, and even became part of a band!

Upon speaking to Ellise's mum, Grace, Legacy became aware that Ellise was struggling mentally due to the lockdown restrictions.

Grace said: *"She really doesn't like that she can't go to Legacy, as she had support there through friends and staff, as well as the band which she really enjoyed and gave her focus. She couldn't perform her music which was an escape for her."*

Knowing that the isolation was impacting Ellise's depression, the team decided it was crucial they do something to support Ellise.

Due to additional funding made by one of Legacy's Founder Patrons, Optivo, Legacy was able to purchase Ellise an electric guitar – a skill Elise had learnt to become amazing at during her visits to Legacy!

Recalling the moment Ellise was told, she said: *"I was in tears, I couldn't believe it; I have something to help me through this time and express what I struggle to say. Performing music means so much to me and I was lost without that ability."*
